

State of health care: Xenex CEO says company is winning war against deadly infections

Xenex Disinfection Services is tackling the issue of healthcare-associated infections, or HAIs, one facility at a time. The San Antonio-based company, which recently secured \$25 million in new funding, now has its patented germ-zapping robots in some 300 hospitals and has its sights on international expansion.

Xenex CEO <u>Morris Miller</u> said the new funding will allow the company to expand its reach and explore new product opportunities.

"We have some new product development ideas, some very creative," Miller said.

Miller is among those selected by a panel that includes San Antonio Business Journal Editor <u>Tony Quesada</u> to present at The Health Cell's 2015 State of the Industry event, which showcases key individuals and organizations that are helping shape San Antonio's multibilliondollar health care and biosciences industry.
