

Xenex sells Germ-Zapping robot to lowa nonprofit hospital

Broadlawns Medical Center has purchased a Xenex Germ-Zapping Robot for use at the Des Moines, Iowa hospital.

San Antonio-based Xenex Disinfection Services manufactures and sells the device, which emits xenon ultraviolent light that eradicates harmful bacteria, viruses, fungi and bacterial spores. Hospitals are buying the devices in order to disinfect patient rooms.

The privately held company specializes in developing and marketing disinfection technology for health care facilties.
