

Xenex Signs Agreement with HealthTrust; Germ-Zapping Robots[™] Added to the HealthTrust Portfolio

The contract, which covers Xenex <u>Germ-Zapping Robots[™]</u>, became effective June 1, 2015.

Xenex's pulsed xenon Full Spectrum[™] ultraviolet (UV) <u>room disinfection</u> <u>solution</u> reduces the bacterial load in hospitals that is often associated with an increased risk for healthcare-associated infections (HAIs). The robot pulses intense UV light covering the entire UV spectrum, destroying viruses, bacteria and bacterial spores in a five-minute disinfection cycle. Without contact or chemicals, the robot eliminates harmful microorganisms safely and effectively. Since its commercial launch in June 2010, Xenex devices are now included in infection control protocols in nearly 300 hospitals, healthcare facilities of the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs and Department of Defense, skilled nursing facilities, ambulatory surgery centers and longterm acute care facilities in the U.S. and Europe.

Using the robots, hospital environmental services staff are able to disinfect 30 to 60 rooms per day—including patient rooms, operating rooms, equipment rooms, emergency rooms, intensive care units and public areas—without disrupting hospital operations."
